A NOTE ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

Tonight's programme is a demonstration of an emerging programme in school music which will lead, it is hoped, to greater community interest and participation in orchestral music making.

From the opening notes the aim is to show a programme of development from Primary school children with very limited experience to the Tauranga Youth Orchestra which is barely a year old, and the Waikato Youth Orchestra, which is just three years old.

In the selection of children the emphasis at this stage has been placed on providing them with the opportunity to take part. It is confidently expected that the standard of performance will continue to rise to the point where an annual concert in May will provide a venue for a Waikato Youth Orchestra performance while a concert in October will give a wider opportunity.

In the meantime it is with pleasure that we present the Primary Schools' Instrumental Scheme Orchestra, Tauranga and Waikato Youth Orchestras, and leave you to judge the level of their achievement.
